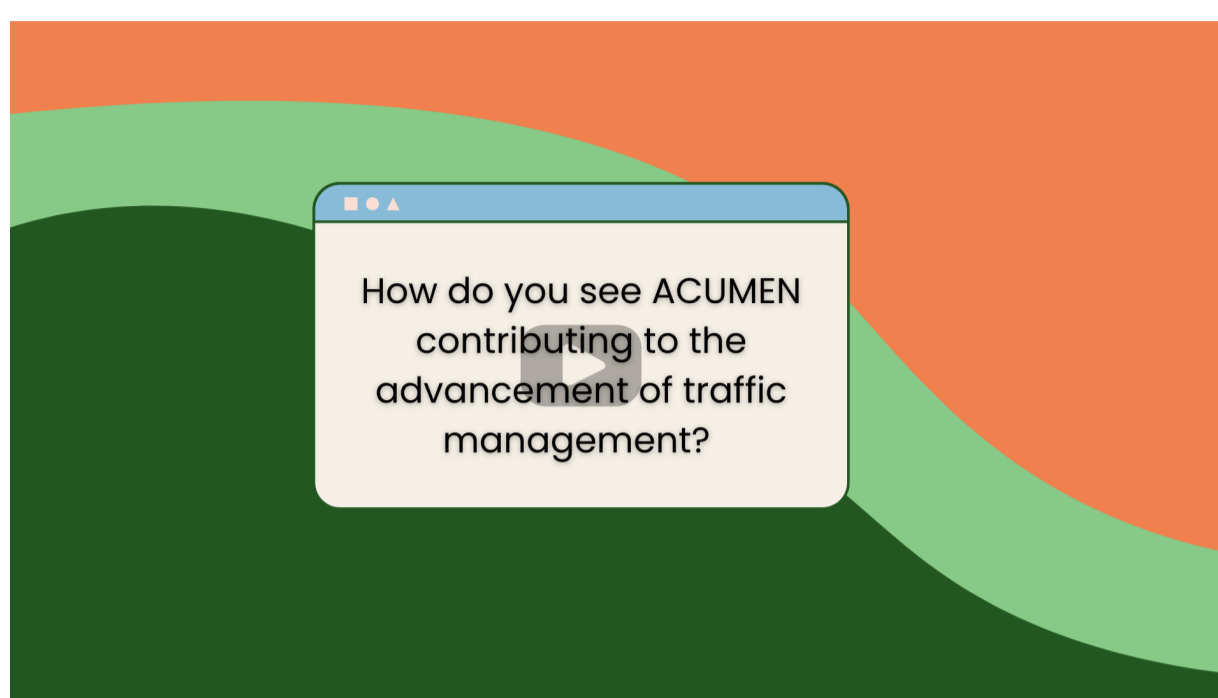

We are now in the final stages of the ACUMEN project and would like to invite you to our joint final event with SYNCHROMODE, which will take place in Brussels on 21–22 April 2026.

This two-day event will bring both projects together to showcase the results, tools and lessons learned over the past three years. The event will present how EU-funded research translates into practical solutions for cities and share real-world deployment experiences from our pilot cities. Attendees will also have the opportunity to explore how multimodal, data-driven traffic management can support sustainable and resilient mobility systems across Europe.

Introducing our partner SYNCHROMODE

For the final event, ACUMEN is teaming up with SYNCHROMODE, ACUMEN's sister project. SYNCHROMODE focuses on developing data-driven ICT tools that support multimodal transport network management. It delivers a suite of services that give transport managers stronger predictive and network optimisation capabilities, helping them balance supply and demand and respond more effectively to different types of events.

SYNCHROMODE's outputs include a network-wide system for data exchange and integration, a cooperative dashboard for real-time monitoring and prediction across multimodal transport and traffic, and a decision-support tool designed to strengthen resilience in multimodal transport and traffic management.

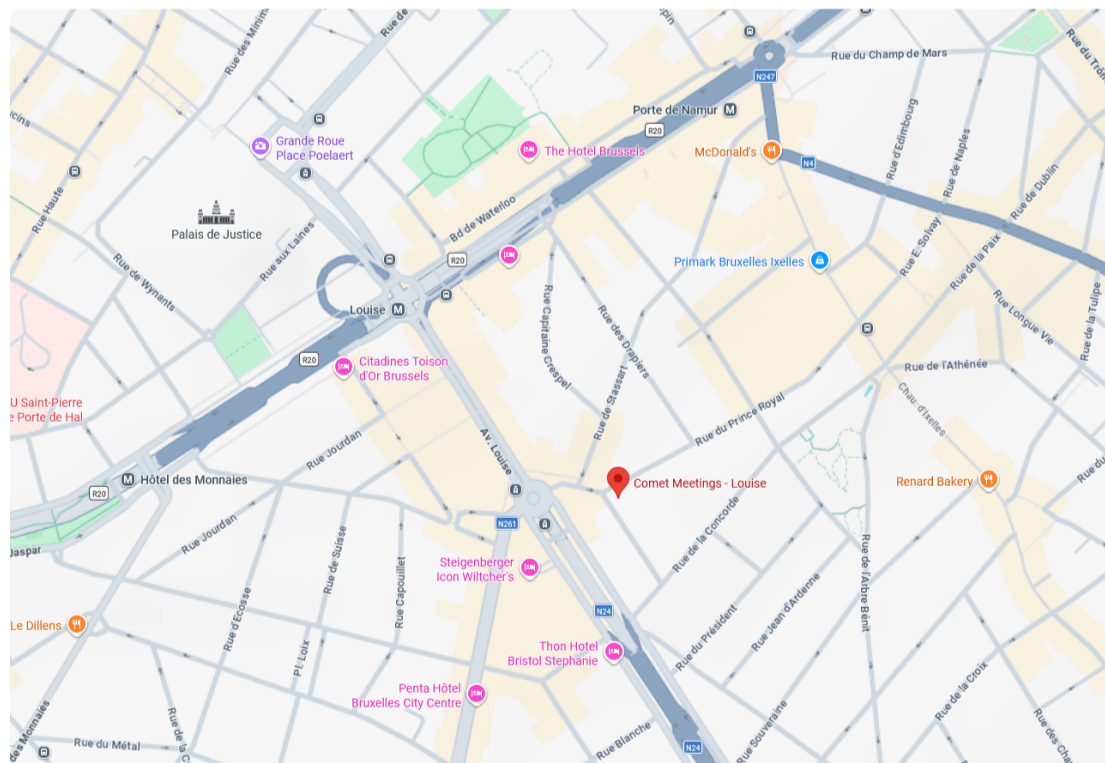
Programme
